Important to note - The evolving nature of the public health challenge means that school districts have to be flexible and prepared to respond to both positive (lower rates of infection) and negative (localized outbreaks) developments. How much this will ultimately impact schools has yet to be determined.
- Short Term Response
 - School Closure was effective in preventing spread
 - Ongoing Social Distancing will get us back faster
 - Parents - Thank you for seeing the big picture.
 - Schools have been effectively locked down, by design and on purpose, since school has closed. This helps to secure the site from a public health perspective.
- Overall Goal
 - Minimize the school setting as a “vector of transmission”

- Mid-Term Response
 - Not to close for the year - Keep Hope Alive
 - Not to close for the year - Delaying decisions that we otherwise could make now
 - What does post-May 15- June 18th look like?
 - School-based traditions - Modify, postpone, or cancel while balancing pressure on families
