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District Update - August 2, 2020 OPT OUT PARENT SURVEY

PLEASE READ
ALL FAMILIES ARE REQUIRED TO RESPOND BY **AUGUST 7**

On July 20th, Governor Murphy announced that families would be allowed to choose an all-remote option. In order to appropriately plan, Maywood now must determine which families will have their child(ren) return to in-person school and which plan to choose an all-remote option. Please understand that the district needs this information to plan for the students who will be attending the in person-hybrid model and those completely opting out. It is only fair to have this information now so that the District can plan appropriately for all students. This information will drive decisions on staffing and grade level configurations, academic models chosen and final planning on a variety of issues. In other words, the first survey regarding opt out intention gave us preliminary data to assist with our final schedule. Now the schedule is done and we need to finalize the essential components of the academic program. Therefore, this information is essential and it is needed in a timely manner from all families.

You have now had a chance to review the school reopening plan and corresponding schedule. Based on the presented information, please answer the survey questions bearing in mind that it pertains to phase one of the transition back to school which runs through mid to late October. Students who are remote only will remain remote only through the end of phase 1. Students who attend in the in person/hybrid schedule may shift to the remote only option at any time after the first day of school.

It is important that we receive survey responses by **noon on Friday, August 7th** with final confirmed decisions from all families. The results of the first survey have been used to plan and discarded and therefore all families need to complete this final survey with their confirmed selection regardless of if they took part in the first survey.

Please also note that we are asking specifically for your child's **grade level that he/she will be entering in September**. We received multiple errors in the submissions of the first survey which made it difficult to plan per grade level. Please be sure to select your child's grade level that he/she will be entering in September on this survey
